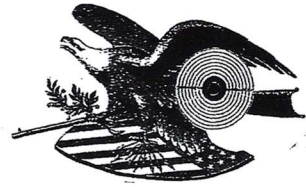

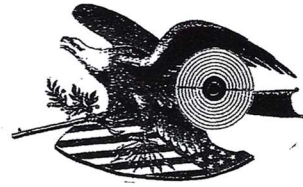

Nickerson High School Trap Team: Done for the year.

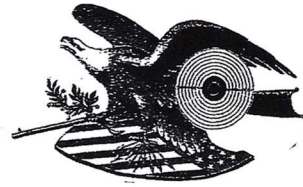

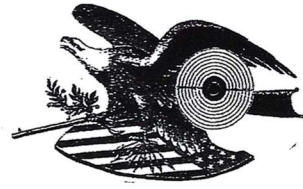

July 23. Zero and equipment checks. Squadded practice before National Matches. John Heger will run the line.

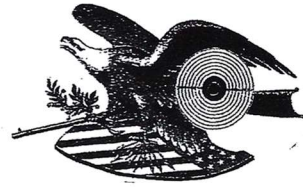
July 27. 600-yard practice. Non-approved prone shooting practice night, 6 to 8 pm. Dennis Chambers will run the line.

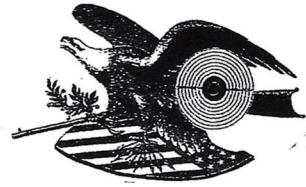
Notes From Yesteryear:
