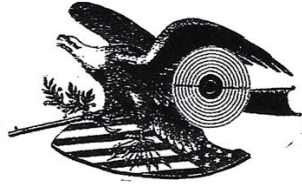
.22 Rimfire Practice Shoot: Dennis runs these also. Done for the year. contact Dennis at the above contact information.

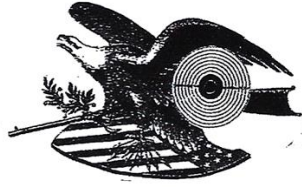
